Recently refurbished throughout and available early October is this exceptionally well presented three-bedroom family home in Kettering.

Set back from the road, the property is entered through a uPVC front door into the entrance hallway with wooden floor.

First reception on the right is a bright room and would normally be the living room, although past occupants have used it as a downstairs bedroom.

The walkthrough dining room has a large window overlooking the private courtyard garden and has an electric wood effect burner. There is a large under stair cupboard with power and plenty of room for a free-standing fridge/freezer.

Recently fitted kitchen has a good range of base and wall mounted units, gas double oven with four ringed burning hob, a double stainless-steel sink with hot cold mixer and space for an undercounter fridge. To the rear of the kitchen is a utility space with plumbing for a washing machine and there's a convenient WC.

Upstairs are three bedrooms, two of which are double in size, and one single. There is a fourth room which could be used as a study or nursery.

A three-piece family bathroom with shower over bath completes the internal accommodation.

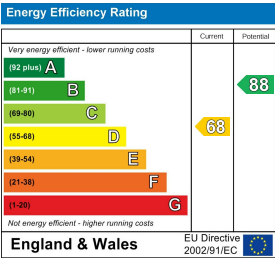
Floor Plan
