

Situation

Tavistock is an ancient stannary and market town located on the edge of the Dartmoor National Park. The town offers a wide range of local and national shops whilst also boasting the renowned pannier market, riverside park, leisure centre and theatre. The area is excellent for visitors both to see the town itself and for exploring the surrounding countryside, the wild Dartmoor scenery and the many neighbouring pretty villages and a variety of National Trust properties. There are exceptional educational facilities in both the state and private sector. The town itself has fantastic sporting facilities including, tennis courts, a bowls club, athletics track and various football pitches. For golf enthusiasts, there are excellent golf courses nearby, at Yelverton and Tavistock and St. Mellion. There are also opportunities to fish by arrangement on a number of local rivers, including the Walkham, Tavy and Tamar.

Directions

Take the A386 Plymouth Road out past Tesco supermarket continue to the roundabout and take a left into the Tiddybrook Estate. Follow Buzzard Road round and take the right hand turn into Kestrel Park. Take another right and continue to the end of this road, taking a slight right and then left taking you to the end of the cul-de-sac where the property can be found ahead of you.



Floor Plan




