

This attractive and well located property offers generous accommodation and tremendous scope for renovation and/or extension (STPP) with no onward chain. Upon entering, you are welcomed by a spacious entrance hallway with stair access, cloakroom, and useful storage, leading directly through to the rear garden and the open-plan kitchen/reception room.
