This three-bedroom terraced house is for sale in Pencoed, near Bridgend, offering neutrally decorated accommodation with two reception rooms, one kitchen and one bathroom. The layout provides defined living and dining areas, with a separate kitchen leading towards the rear of the property.

A key feature is the south-facing garden, which offers outdoor space with good natural light, suitable for everyday use and low-key entertaining. The property is in Council Tax Band C.

Pencoed provides a range of local amenities including shops, cafés and everyday services in the town centre. There are nearby schools catering for primary and secondary ages within the local area, making the location practical for households needing access to education.

with carpets, skimmed walls and ceiling, with central lighting, two windows to rear, radiator.


Gardens

South facing rear gardens with concrete patio area against the back of the house, rear lawn with concrete path leading to rear parking which is accessed via rear lane.


Area Map
