The Indoors

As you step through the front door, you're welcomed by a bright, well-planned hallway that connects you effortlessly to every corner of the home. Directly to your left, integrated storage units offer a practical entryway, forming a natural guide into the apartment.

At the end of the hallway, the space opens into a light-filled living and kitchen area. Floor-to-ceiling windows span the entire length of the room, opening out onto a private balcony that stretches from the living area all the way to the main bedroom. Inside, there's plenty of room for both a comfortable sofa and TV setup as well as a dining area. The kitchen, cleverly tucked into this open space, feels intimate yet practical. It's clean and clutter-free, with sleek wooden countertops, tiled splashback, and built-in appliances including an oven, dishwasher, fridge freezer, and space for a washing machine. There's ample storage for cutlery and cookware, making everyday living and hosting effortless.

Heading back to the hallway on the right, the main bathroom features both a full-sized bathtub and overhead shower, complemented by clean modern fixtures for a polished, timeless look. On the left, the main bedroom is a cosy, carpeted space, with room for a double bed, fitted wardrobes, and a large window that invites natural light all day long.

Further down the hallway, the second bedroom mirrors the same warm, carpeted feel and is equally bright thanks to floor-to-ceiling windows. It's a versatile space, perfect as a guest room, home office, or children's bedroom —with enough space for a bed and wardrobe.

The Outdoors



The living area opens out onto a private balcony that stretches from the living area all the way to the main bedroom. It's a beautiful outdoor space with room for a small sofa or café table set—perfect for morning coffees or taking in the peaceful views over the canal and neighbourhood beyond

Waterfront House is quietly nestled along the edge of Millfields Park, offering residents direct access to green open space and the calming towpaths of the canal. Just minutes away, Chatsworth Road offers a thriving stretch of independent cafés, restaurants, and shops. From the comforting bowls at Men Ramen Café to the artisanal finds at L'epicerie 56, and the Sunday Street market, there's something for everyone.











Floor Plans Location Map
