### Loving The Location

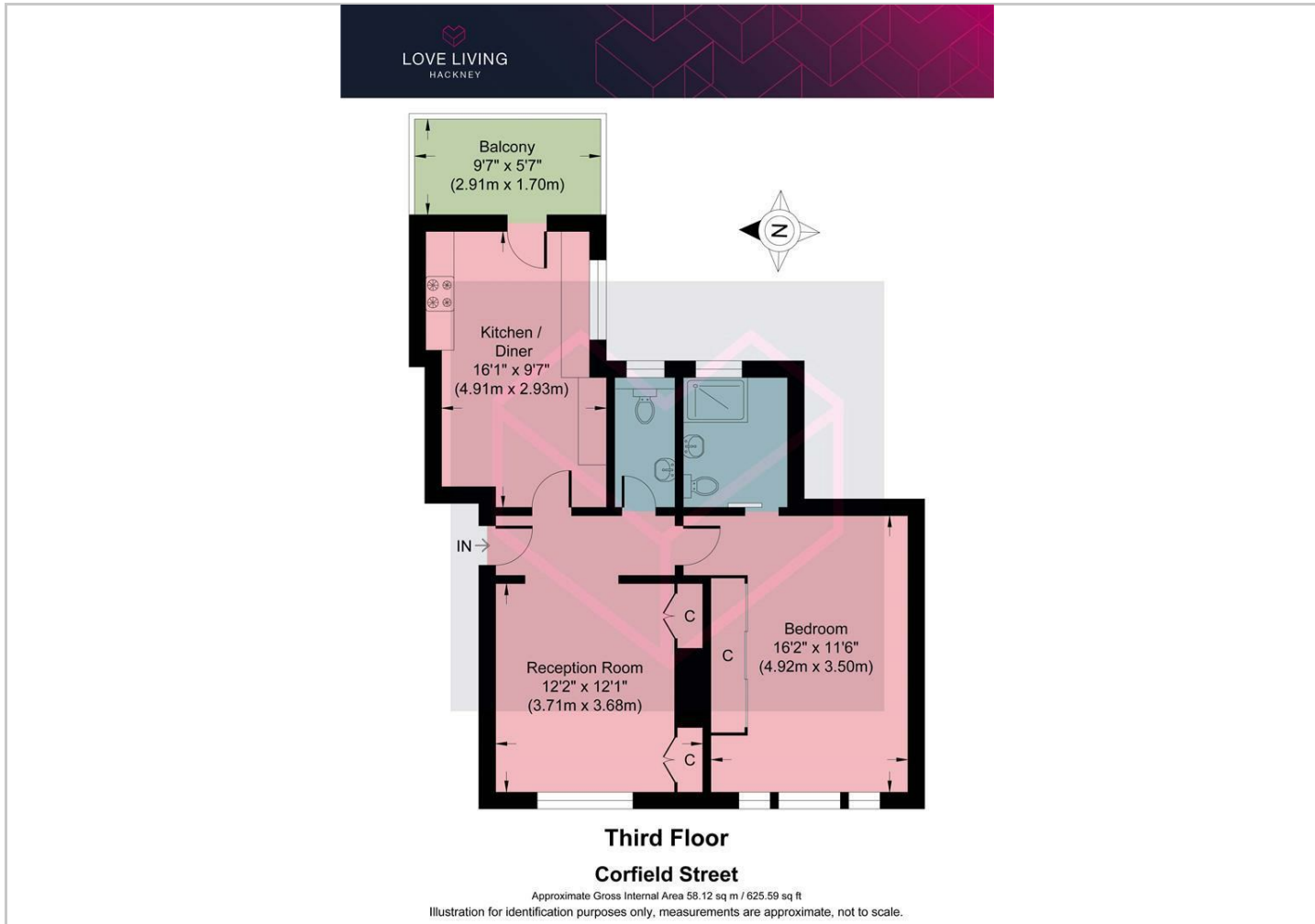
Bethnal Green is one of the most established east London neighbourhoods. The area has an exciting mix of traditional pubs and cafes, such as E Pellicci, Breid Bakers, the famous Tayyabs in Whitechapel and The Approach Tavern, as well as a new wave of bars and restaurants, including Brawn, Redchurch Brewery and Sager + Wilde on Paradise Row. Common E2 is just around the corner for coffee. The area is home to many design and architecture practices as well as great small commercial galleries, including Maureen Paley, Modern Art, and Herald St. Brick Lane, Shoreditch and Hackney are all close by offering some of London's most famous cafes, restaurants, shops, markets and nightlife options.

Broadway Market and Columbia Road Flower Market are within easy walking distance of Wilmot Street, while an enjoyable walk along Regent's Canal leads to Victoria Park and Haggerston Park. The V&A Museum of Childhood is very close by, as is York Hall Leisure Centre. Corfield Street is located within four minute walk from Bethnal Green overground station. Bethnal Green underground station gives access to the Central line and is five minute walk away, whilst Whitechapel station is a short walk giving access to the new Elizabeth line. There are excellent bus links to Hackney, central London and beyond.





## Floor Plans



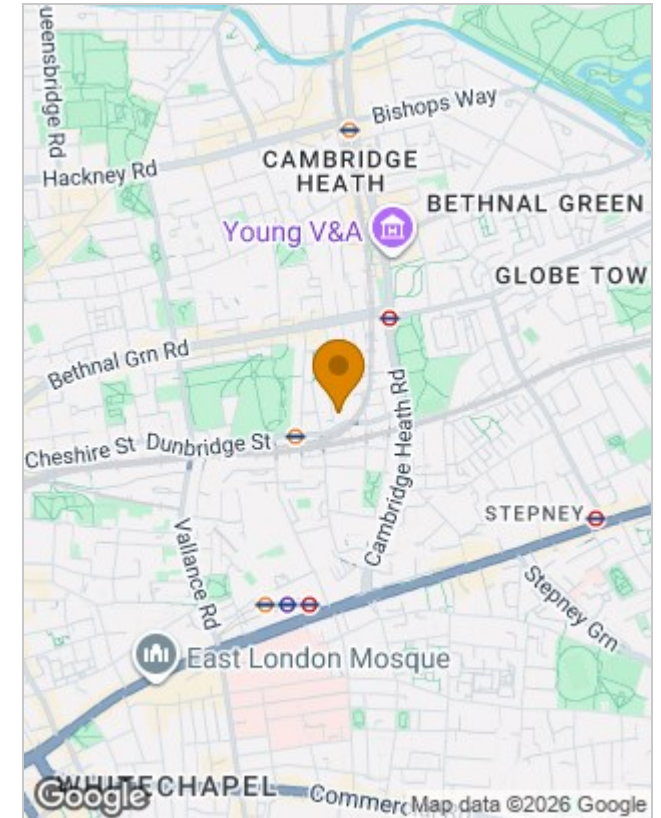
