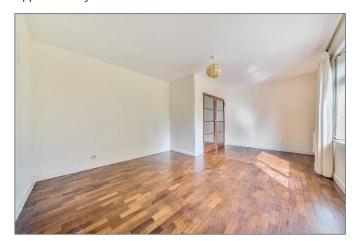
A Rarely Available 4/5 Bedroom Detached Bungalow in Preston

Situated in a desirable village location on a quiet no-through road, this spacious 4/5-bedroom detached bungalow offers an excellent opportunity for those seeking a home with potential. The property provides generous accommodation throughout and would now benefit from some modernisation and improvement, allowing the next owner to create their ideal home.

The layout includes three well-proportioned reception rooms, with the sitting room to the rear and enjoying delightful views over the garden and fields beyond. The kitchen is fitted with a range of wall and base units, with space for appliances, and leads through to a breakfast room. A useful utility room, cloakroom, and study/bedroom 5 add further practicality.

The bedrooms are located to the right-hand side of the entrance hall, two of which include built-in wardrobes, and bedroom one benefits from an en-suite shower room.

Outside, the bungalow is set behind its front garden. A driveway provides off-road parking and leads to a detached garage. The rear garden is of a good size, mainly laid to lawn with a variety of established trees and shrubs, and enjoys wonderful open views. Overall the plot measures approximately 0.34 acres.

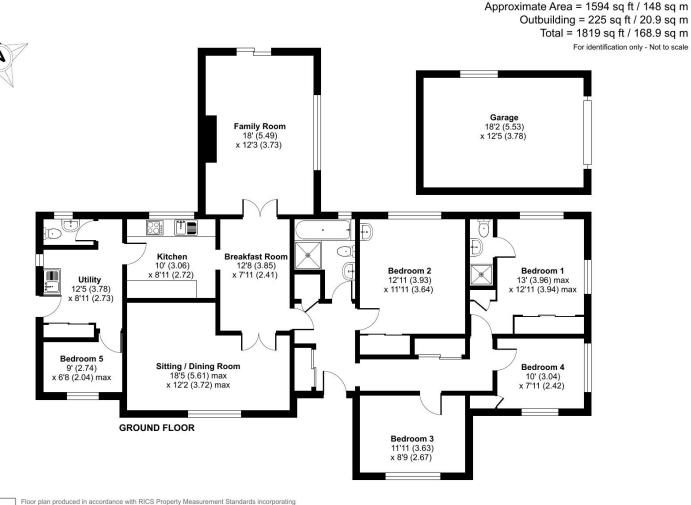

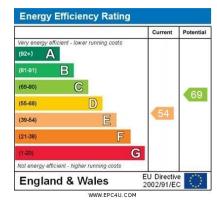
