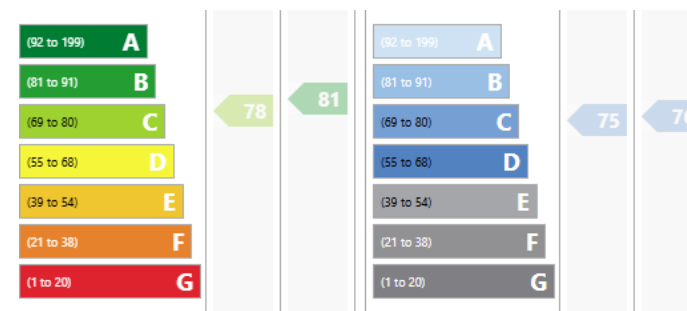

Property Description

This impressive, detached four bedroomed villa, offers well-proportioned accommodation throughout and is spread over two floors. This property is tucked away in a quiet location, in the small village of Edderton. Offering a wealth of features including four double bedrooms, one of which can be utilised as an office, perfect for those who work from home, ample storage provisions, double glazing and oil fired central heating. Viewing is highly recommended to appreciate the size of the accommodation on offer. Upon entering the property, you are met with the wooden entrance porch, which in turn leads to a generously sized lounge with French doors that provides access to the front patio area, ideally positioned for al-fresco dining. Also located on the ground floor is a WC and the kitchen/diner which has wall and base mounted units, with worktops, splashback tiling, a stainless steel sink with mixer tap and drainer. Integrated appliances include a double electric oven and hob with extractor hood over. Off the kitchen can be found a useful utility room which boasts base units, a stainless steel sink with mixer tap and has a washing machine and tumble dryer which are included in the sale. There is a door in the utility room which gives access to the rear garden. Completing the ground floor accommodation is a double bedroom with fitted wardrobes. On the first floor can be found a further three bedrooms, with dormer windows, with the principal bedroom boasting a walk-in wardrobe, and an en-suite shower room. The family bathroom can be found on the first floor comprising of a WC, a pedestal wash hand basin, a heated towel rail, thermostatic shower enclosure with wet walling, a bathtub and is finished with ceramic floor tiles.

Externally, the property sits on a large plot and the boundaries are clearly marked by fencing. There is a shared gravel driveway providing ample space for parking several vehicles and in turn leads to the single garage, which has power, lighting and an electric up and over door. Also sited here are two timber sheds, which is included in the sale. Edderton is a scattered village 5 miles from Tain, lying on the southern shores of the Dornoch Firth. There is a sense of community spirit here with events taking place in the village hall and a mobile library and post office. There is a school bus which runs to the secondary school, Tain Royal Academy. Edderton is home to Balblair Distillery, which featured in the film. "The Angel's Share".
