The lower ground floor provides two substantial double bedrooms, one with direct access to the large private rear garden. Striking herringbone-style stripped wooden flooring runs throughout this level, adding warmth and cohesion. The bathroom, replaced a couple of years ago, is a stunning fully tiled contemporary space with a crisp three-piece white suite.

Upstairs, the ground floor offers a superb reception room measuring almost 16ft x 12ft, with stripped wooden flooring and a seamless flow into a delightful kitchen diner. A huge rear window overlooks the garden and fills the space with light.

The rear garden is a true sanctuary – a quiet oasis ideal for relaxing, entertaining and play. It also includes a separate garden room, currently used as a home office.

Further benefits include neutral décor, share of freehold with just one other owner and no service charges.

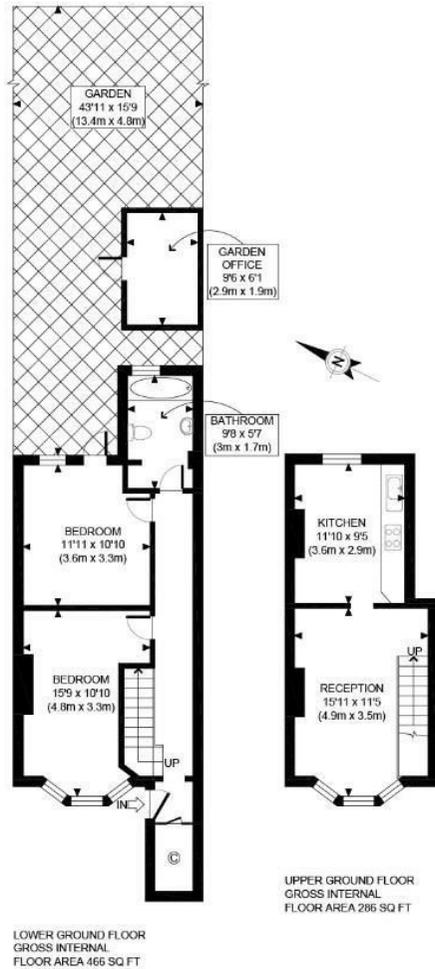

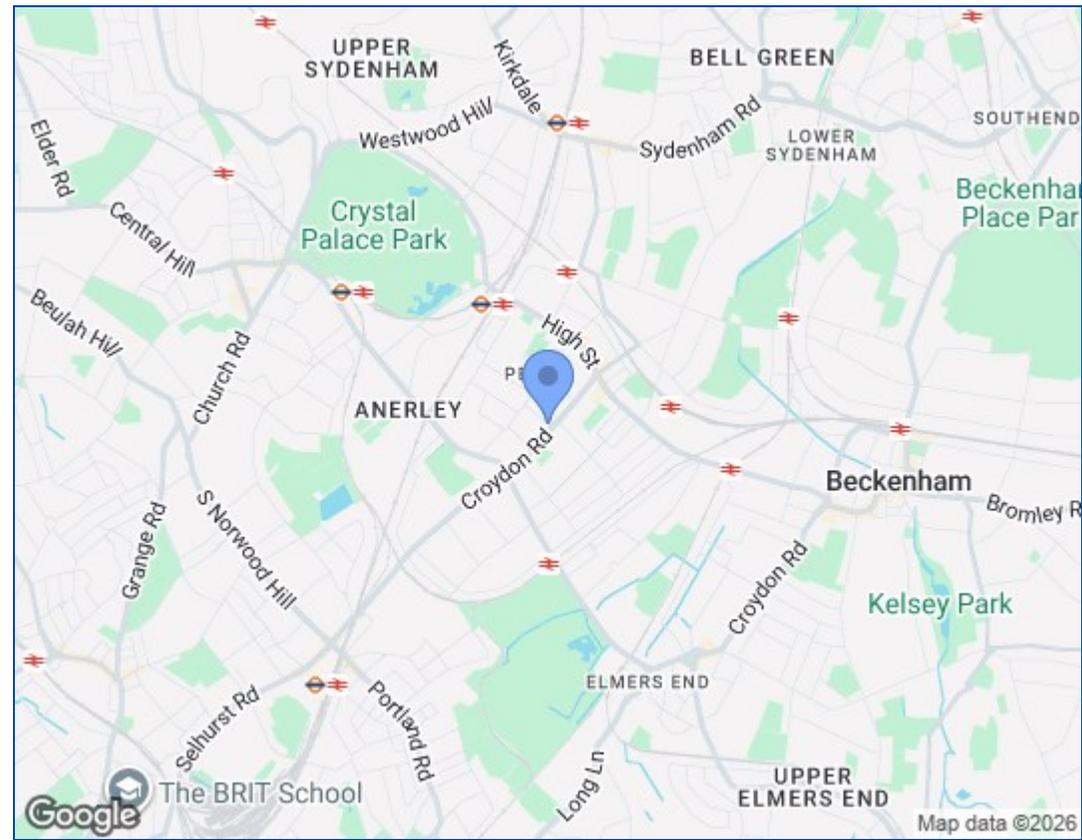






APPROX. GROSS INTERNAL FLOOR AREA WITH STORAGE/SHED 810 SQ FT / 75 SQM
