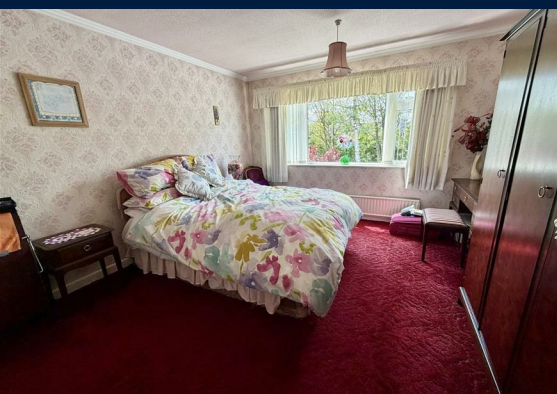

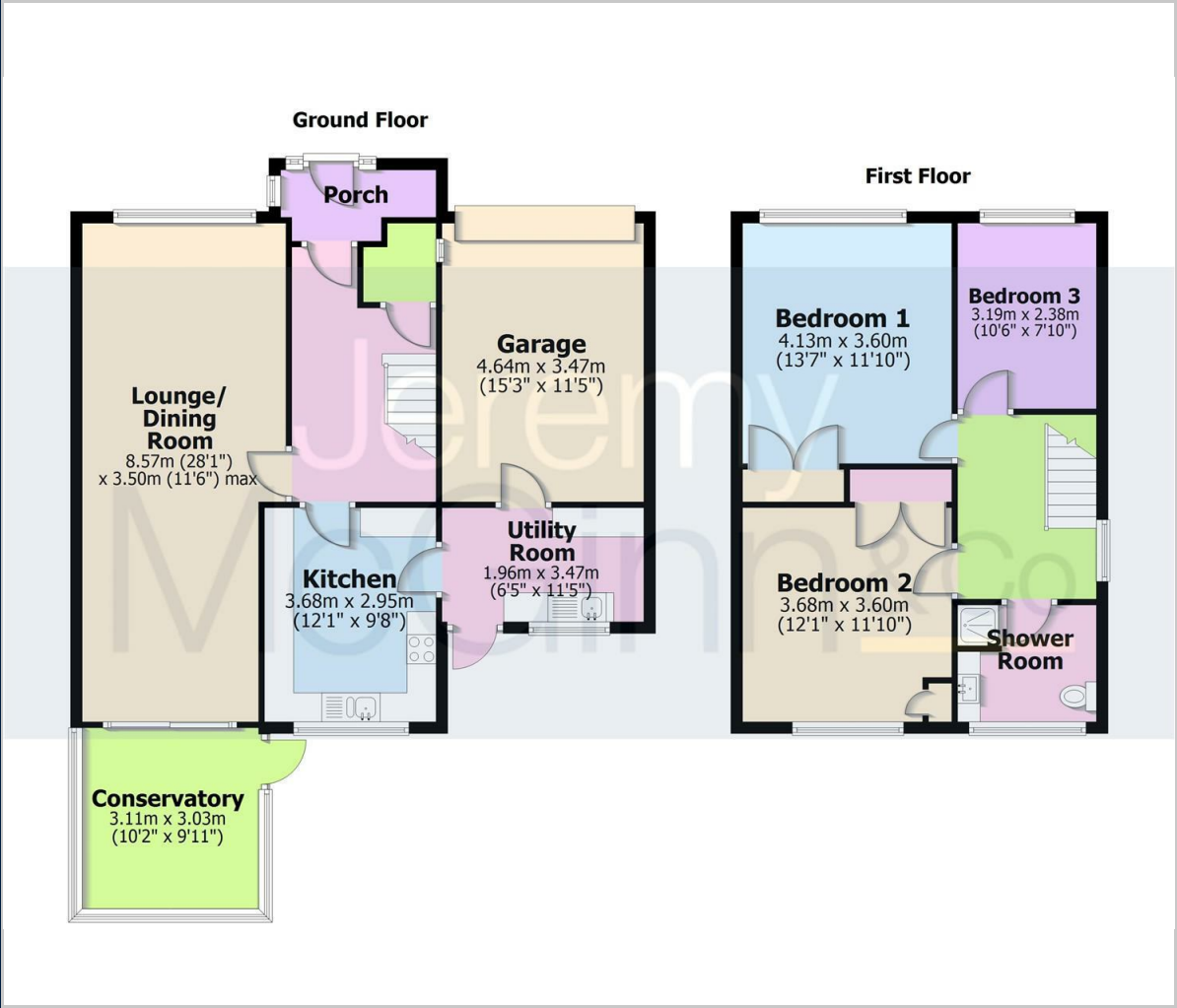

Excellent amenities can be found in Alcester including a range of independent shops & cafes in addition to restaurants & pubs and a Waitrose supermarket.

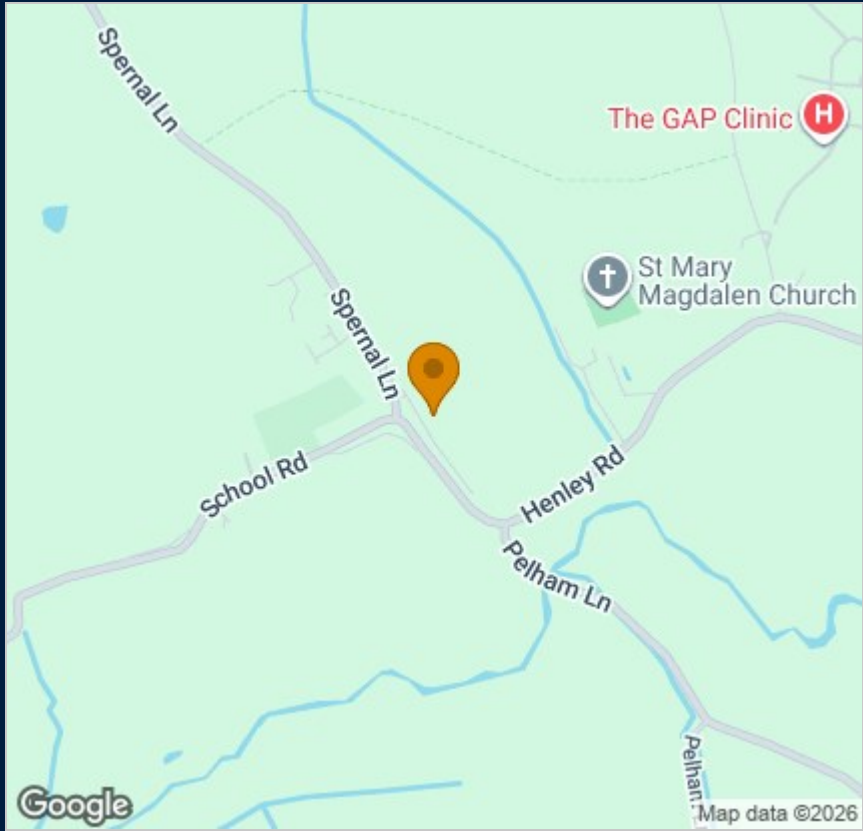

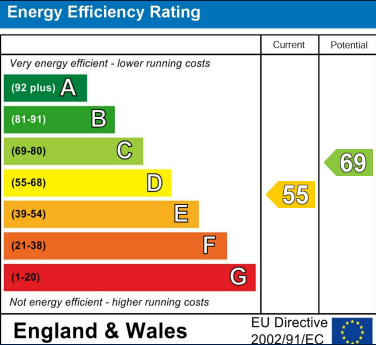
Floor Plan
