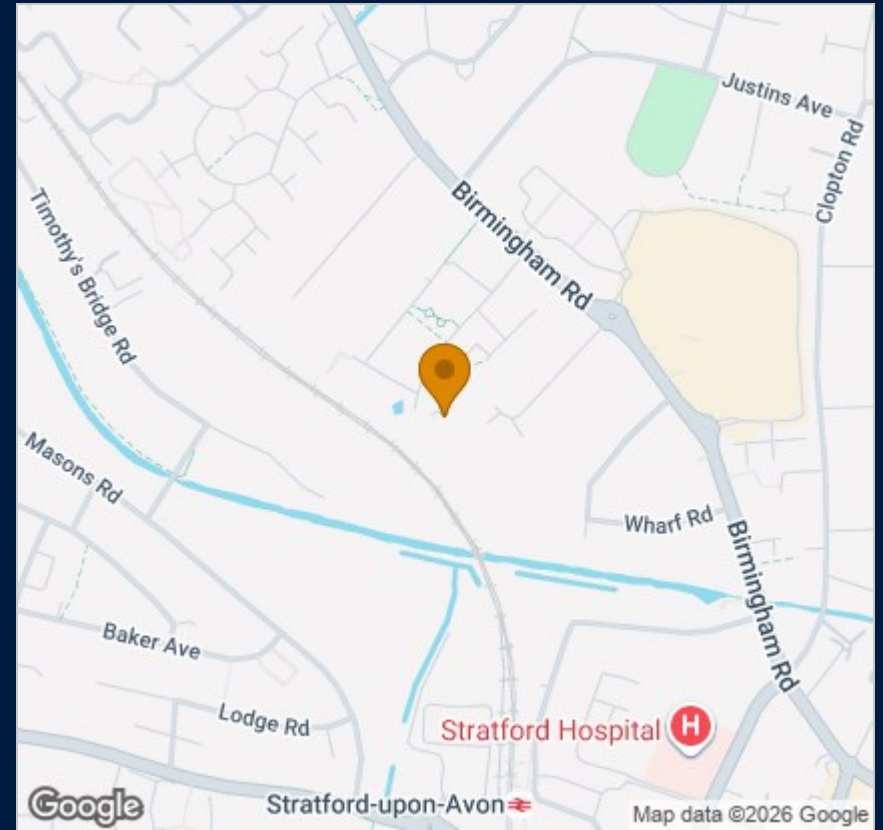

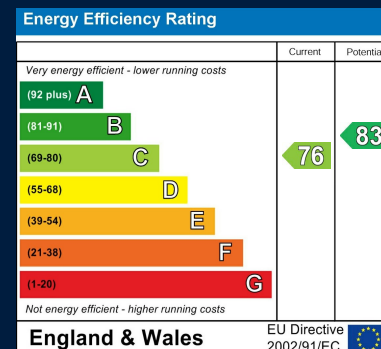
Floor Plan
