Floor Plan



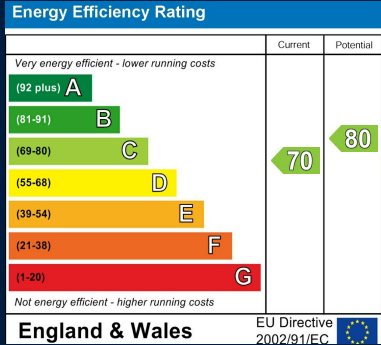
