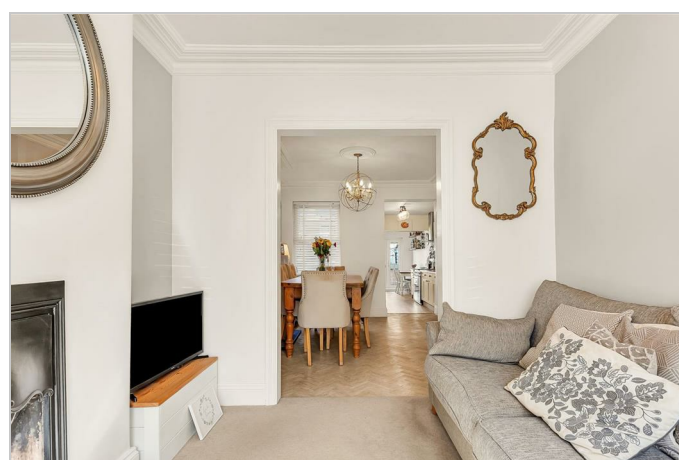

Conveniently located within the highly popular Castle Road area, this period end of terrace home offers thoughtfully improved and renovated accommodation, arranged over three floors. The living room is carefully separated into two areas - a cosy sitting area to the front and a walk-through dining area leading to the kitchen/breakfast room which has plenty of storage and workspace and French doors opening to the rear garden. The first floor provides bedrooms two and three as well as a modern and spacious bathroom, replaced two years ago, which includes a freestanding bath, large shower cubicle and dual wash hand basins. The converted loft is home to the main or guest bedroom and provides a light-filled space with Velux windows, eaves storage and built-in wardrobes. Further features include uPVC double glazed windows (some in the sash style) and gas to radiator heating from a recently replaced combination boiler. Outside, the courtyard garden has been landscaped to provide patio and lawn areas with raised planters and direct access to the side passageway for bicycles and bins.

The 'Castle Quarter' of the town offers a choice of cafes, coffee shops and delis as well as popular pubs and restaurants. Russell Park is at the end of the road with The Embankment just beyond and the area is also home to a highly-regarded Primary School and free to enter museums. Bedford town centre is only a short walk away and offers a wider choice of shops as well as fast rail links into London St Pancras. EER: TBC
