Description

Superbly modernised, this two double bedroom terraced house offers 1126 sq.ft.incl.cellar whilst situated in Leatherhead's conservation area just a short walk to the town centre and mainline train station.

Newly double glazed and with scope to create a third bedroom or extra reception room in the cellar, the light a spacious accommodation comprises lovely sitting room with bay window, dining room and newly extended fitted kitchen with double doors to the rear garden and terrace.

Upstairs, both the principle bedroom and second double bedroom have fitted wardrobes and share a large modern family bathroom.

Outside, the rear garden has a South Easterly aspect with a beautifully made decking incorporating steps to the lawn and gravel garden path to the a rear garden gate.

Situation

Leatherhead town offers a comprehensive range of shopping facilities including the Swan Shopping Centre, theatre, Waitrose Local and Nuffield Health Fitness Gym. The public leisure centre is located on the edge of the town.

The main line railway station offers fast and frequent services north to London terminals and there are separate branch lines south to Dorking and Guildford. Junction 9 of the M25 is only a two-minute drive away, providing easy access to both. Gatwick and Heathrow Airports.

There is a wide range of quality private and state schooling in the general area. Private schools include St. John's in Leatherhead, Downsends School, City of London Freeman's School in Ashted and state schools include St Andrew's RC School and Therfield Secondary School, both in Leatherhead.

In the near vicinity there are hundreds of acres of Green Belt countryside much of which is National Trust owned. On the doorstep are Polesden Lacey, Bocketts farm and Epsom Downs where the famous Derby is held.
